<sup>1</sup>National Institutes of Health (NIH) COVID-19 ordinal scale: 1) Not hospitalized and no limitations of activities

2) Not hospitalized, with limitation of activities, home oxygen (O<sub>2</sub>) requirement, or both

3) Hospitalized, not requiring supplemental O<sub>2</sub> and no longer requiring ongoing medical care

4) Hospitalized, not requiring supplemental O<sub>2</sub> but requiring ongoing medical care

5) Hospitalized, requiring any supplemental O<sub>2</sub>

6) Hospitalized, requiring noninvasive ventilation or use of high-flow O<sub>2</sub> devices

7) Hospitalized, receiving invasive mechanical ventilation or extracorporeal membrane oxygenation

8) Death
